<p>Cost: \$25/Group Social skills group participation is based on your child's needs determined in your initial consultation. Groups will vary per year depending on the growth of your child and his/her needs at that time. Social groups are billed as a monthly tuition based on the scheduled number of groups. Credits are not given for missed groups, unless our staff has to cancel due to illness or weather. <p>Mileage for areas outside Birmingham area will be billed as an additional 1-2 hours of service for driving time, unless agreed upon differently in initial agreement. Most of our current agreements are set up as IRS current mileage rates. This will be determined upon agreement of services.</p>	<p>Cost: \$850 Many school systems arrange for an IEE to be completed, typically due to parental request. An IEE will be completed with observation and record review for one student.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Record review • 10 Hours of Observation • Written report including written recommendations
